5. Bovis Homes

Lichfield District Council had confirmed that the obligation for the land to be used as a Doctors Surgery was no longer valid. Cllr Wilcox had notified Bovis Homes that repairs were needed to the boundary fence and that the land had become overgrown. He had requested that the work was carried out before any potential acquisition of the site by the Parish Council.
