## **4. Reports from BKV Work Groups;**

## **5. BKV Meeting;**

Cllr Roberts discussed in depth the future needs of the BKV Competition. This was on worksheets that had been supplied via Cllr Beaumont. This was x2 sheets with suggested areas of work and time schedules, including the making of Posters and where the most effective sites for these could be found.

## **6. CCTv;**

A discussion was held regarding the need for CCTv. The discussion was centred around what equipment was required. This would be a lighting post with x3 LED lights and Cameras to be sited at various points within the area. The supply point of the Electric connection has been agreed with the Youth and Community Hall

## **7. Fradley Park Development;**

A verbal report was given, where all Businesses on this site are encouraged to join together and form a Business Improvement District (BID). A feasibility study is being considered. The conditions for this and joining the BID are available from Lichfield District Council.

**8. Bridge Farm Road;**

The Acting Clerk had contacted the County, with regards to Tree and Low branch problems along this road. Maintenance has now been completed within this area. Local residents would like to see further reductions of hedges, this will be taken up with County by themselves. Councillor Eagland is aware of this problem. There appears to be a permanent vehicle parked in this area, Lichfield District Council to be made aware of this.

**9. Dog Bins;**

The Canal and River Trust (CART) have informed the PCnl that one of the designated Dog Bins will be removed to another location, as there is a bin within this locality.

**10. Highways / Footpaths / Village Appearance;**

The areas of discussion included, Highway weed problems, potholes in the Footpaths, Open Spaces for the BKV competition.
